Who is Love Your Neighbor Ministries? – LYNM exists to reach out in compassion to people in the full range of healthcare settings. This includes hospitals, nursing homes, retirement communities, hospice care and private homes. Our purpose, stated simply is: "Equipping Churches for Ministries of Compassion."

Our immediate objective is to minister to the people who are facing health changes, but our ministry also includes their families and caregivers as well. Our ministry takes primarily three forms: 1) Our chaplains provide pastoral care in health care institutions. 2) volunteers from local evangelical churches are trained for personal and group ministries, mainly to the people in nursing and retirement homes. 3) We develop resources for training and equipping both our chaplains and volunteers and the general Christian public in issues related to aging and healthcare.

This led to her sharing her faith with a young caregiver who was going through the breakup of a relationship.
